Preamble Of The Conference:

The concept of Islamic social finance was used for the first time in February 2014 by the Islamic Development Bank Institute (formerly the Islamic Research and Training Institute (IRTI)), and it means any financing directed for a purpose or social investment and subject to the provisions, rules and objectives of Islamic Sharia, and it also refers to the provision of services Financial inclusion for the weak strata of society to ensure a fair redistribution of wealth, and then achieve financial inclusion and social and economic well-being. It is a diversified and multi-modal financing, which is divided into:

A. Charitable social funding (non-profit): It is based on donations, charity and charity; Such as a good loan, voluntary alms, zakat, endowment, Takaful insurance, vows, bequests, and penances...

B. For-profit social financing: It is based on profitability, which takes into account the social aspects, and at the same time seeks to ensure the sustainability of financing, and in turn is divided into: social financing by netting and social financing by participation.

While the world is still floundering in the face of the Covid-19 pandemic, on May 11, 2021, the United Nations, in partnership with the Islamic Development Bank, launched an initiative to better support efforts to finance recovery, including:

While the fragility of social and economic systems has become apparent to the whole world, especially in the time of the pandemic, Islamic social financing tools provide an opportunity for resilience.... I am confident that zakat, charity, endowment and Islamic microfinance are tools that allow the adoption of a more flexible and comprehensive development approach, based on the bottom-up I look forward to working with our partners in the United Nations to mainstream these tools to meet urgent needs and achieve sustainable development goals" (Mohamed Hegaz, 2021)

"Islamic social finance based on the principles of equity and justice would support the quest to overcome financial constraints, underfunding and inequality in financing, and would open new horizons to stimulate economic activity, enhance social welfare, achieve financial inclusion and shared prosperity... and by using financial services technology (fintech) and artificial intelligence, we can better manage zakat, endowments and Islamic microfinance." Islamic social finance tools help governments and societies meet a range of development needs, but the formal use of these tools to care for the poor, the destitute, and the underprivileged remains limited.

In this context, Algeria has recently tended to urge all national and foreign banks operating in Algeria to open windows for Islamic banking.

- The research paper in Arabic should be written in the Traditional Arabic font, size 14 for the text, and the spacing of 1.15 between the lines, and in foreign languages, the Time New Roman font, the size of 12 for the text, and the distance of 1.15 between the lines, and 2 cm for the page borders in all directions.
- The number of pages of the research paper should not exceed 20 pages, including the margins and references
- Margins, references and appendices are inserted in APA style in an automated manner

- Only the research paper accepted by the Scientific Committee will be answered
- The target themes must be written at the beginning of the research paper with the researcher's data: "Name and title of the researcher, scientific rank, University, affiliation laboratory, if any."
